The following measures will take place during operating during the COVID-19 Pandemic:

- 1 Employees will be expected to independently keep up to date on COVID-19 developments.
- 2 Employees will be expected to undergo COVID-19 Webinar for safety education.
- 3 Employees will be expected to help prevent the spread through diligent hygiene and PPE use.
- 4 Employees will be expected to be transparent about travel plans and or confirmed contact with COVID-19 positive individuals to implement 14-day minimum self-isolation measures.
